Since 2021, **Micron Singapore** has sponsored several essential equipment for our clients, including a state-of-the-art Virtual Reality (VR) wheelchair training simulator. The VR simulator is designed to be an immersive and safe space where our clients can learn how to operate and navigate with a motorised wheelchair. The system also presents our clients with various virtual scenarios that help them improve their decision making and problem-solving skills.

In March 2023, our Occupational Therapy (OT) department hosted a team from Micron Singapore to share on the progress on the VR simulator. Our OT Andrea demonstrated how staff would use the system during their therapy sessions, and the Micron Singapore team had an opportunity to try out the simulator for themselves.
