

Equipment & Resource Loan Library



The OT department's Equipment & Resource Loan Library facilitates parents and caregivers to try new equipment to check its effectiveness on a child or student before they purchase therapy equipment, Assistive Technology (AT) and adaptive devices, and special feeding devices and utensils. Additionally, parents and caregivers are encouraged to borrow any necessary equipment to provide therapy during holidays and for emergency purpose such as post-operative care.

What Can Be Borrowed?

CPAS Occupational Therapy Department provides a variety of equipment for loan such as:

- Therapy equipment
- Feeding devices
- Adaptive devices
- Assistive Technology devices (AT)
- Mobility devices (Wheelchairs)
- Sensory tools

Examples of what can be borrowed:

- Therapy Equipment and Adaptive Devices



Therapy equipment can be used to facilitate your child's performance and ability; adaptive devices enhance independence with daily living skills. Equipment loan library contains a variety of equipment and devices such as therapy balls, adjustable benches, weighted vest, gaiters, etc

- Assistive Technology Devices



AT Devices enhances accessibility to technology for individuals with physical limitations. Available AT devices include Alternative Keyboards, Joy Stick, Switch Operated Toys, Power Link @4 Controls Unit, etc.

How Do I Borrow?

- Approach your Occupational Therapist (OT) and explain your requirements
- OT recommends appropriate equipment
- Pay non - refundable loan-fee & refundable Deposit and borrow any equipment for 6 weeks.
